



## ASANTE REGIONAL CANCER CENTER

**Need:** Over 2,000 new cases of cancer are diagnosed each year in Jackson and Josephine counties. That number is expected to grow by nearly 20% over the next 10 years. Currently, Asante's cancer patients must go to several different places to get lab tests, imaging, radiation, chemotherapy, doctor consultations and other services. The new regional cancer center will put all of those outpatient services under one roof.

**Cost:** \$64 million

**Size:** 79,000 square feet

**Location:** East of Asante Rogue Regional Medical Center, with access from Barnett Road and Doctors Park Drive

**Duration:** Groundbreaking begins in February, with completion expected in winter 2021

### Features

- Private spaces with expansive views for infusion patients
- Expanded nurse navigator and social work programs to help guide patients through treatment
- Support services, including diagnostic imaging, retail pharmacy, laboratory and nutrition
- Complementary care, including support groups, oncological massage and donation resource center
- Office space for specialists to consult with patients and their families
- Telemedicine, bone marrow clinic and gynecological oncology
